DRUG IDENTIFICATION & TESTING STRIP TRAINING

JULY 2 2024, 1PM

Jana Baller with Fraser Health will be providing this training to staff and Community members. We will start with lunch and training will begin at 1 pm. Training will be approximately 1½ hours annd will also include the different types of drugs, what the substance looks like and the effects.

"Drug checking is a harm reduction service that allows people to determine what is in their substances and potentially take action to reduce the risk of any associated harms. Fentanyl test strips can detect fentanyl and some fentanyl analogues in a drug sample. They are easy to use and results are instant. This course will provide guidance on how to use fentanyl test strips at point-of-care, or as a take-home option. It will give additional information about drug checking in context, how to communicate instructions and how to read test strip results."
